

From OVV Territorial Governor Marcus Allen, here are some notes about the TG meeting at Winter Range.

1. The Colt-Burgess rifle has been proposed to be legal in Classic Cowboy AND B Western. This would make it the only rifle legal in all SASS Categories.
2. Because this incident has come up.....A fully cocked and loaded pistol that has been returned to a holster....WILL NOW BE A MATCH DQ. TG will vote this in at the next Summit.
3. Again being re-introduced and hoping the TGs talk to their prospective clubs.....an overloaded rifle will not suffer a double penalty.

Example:

Loading a rifle with 10 rounds and the stage calls for 9 rounds. Under the present regs....it is a procedural penalty (10 secs) for 10 rounds and a minor safety penalty for the 10th round.

Under the new proposed reg....a competitor now will have the option to lever out a single round and continue the stage with no penalties. This assumes that the rifle will have no rounds in the chamber or on the carrier when the rifle is placed on the stage prop after firing.
